



We will endeavour to contact all parents via the Schoolcomms system. This system sends a message to parents' mobile phones. If you have recently changed your mobile number, please inform the school office. Alternatively, log on to our school website for the latest details about emergency closure. <u>www.st-marys-fal.cornwall.sch.uk</u>

In the event for example of heavy snow during the school day, you the parents are in the best position to assess the road conditions etc. where you live. If you need to collect your child early then this is acceptable. The school will remain open until all pupils have been collected.
