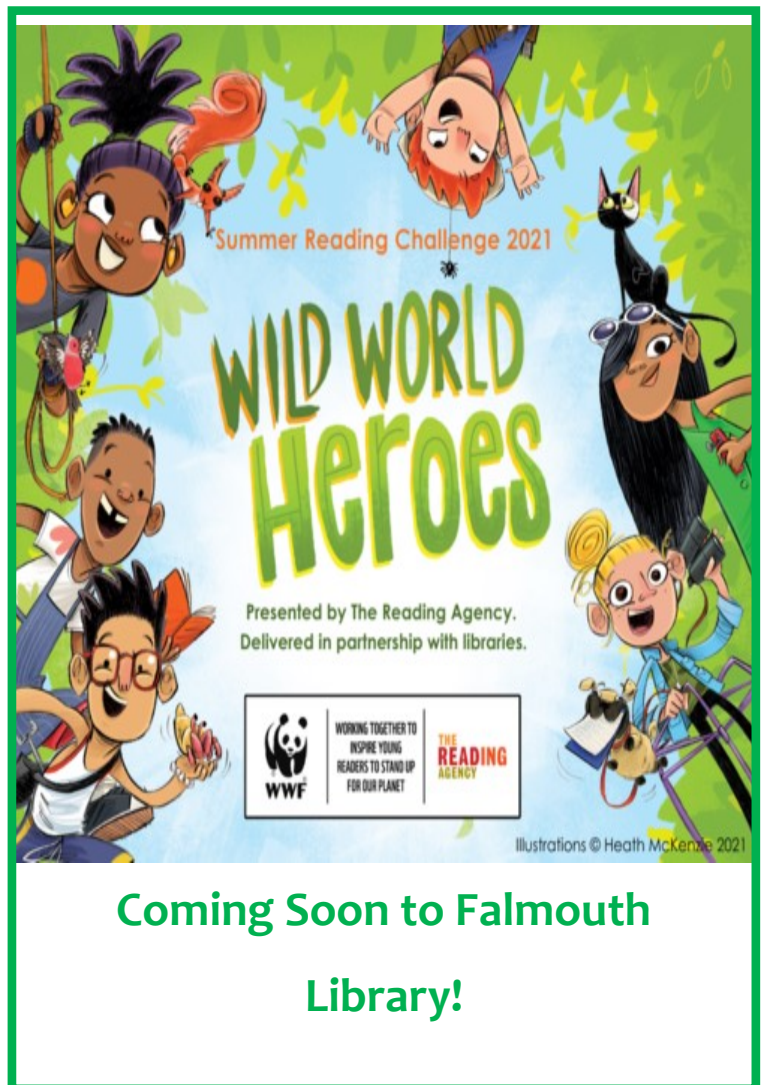

## Letter from the Presbytery

2<sup>nd</sup> July 2021

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I do hope you are all safe and well.

Back in the 1960's there was a popular folk/protest song called 'Where have all the flowers gone?' Many priests are asking 'where have all the parishioners gone?' I am very conscious that many in our community who came to Mass before the first lockdown in March 2020 have still not returned to our churches. Of course, some will have valid health reasons for this, however, many will not and it is their choice in not returning. In the last few days I have had my haircut, had a meal in a restaurant and attended the theatre in Plymouth. All normal activities that I experienced pre-covid and I am able to experience once again.
