BIG Question:

Why is it important to look after our home?

For our focus we will be discussing why it is so important to look after our home and wider world. Recalling our work during the Spring term about our locality, we will be building upon our knowledge of Falmouth through mapwork. We will identify the animals, weather and key features of our locality and then compare and contrast with other environments around the world. Which observations will we make? Additionally, we will be taking time to reflect on the Summer season and identifying how to stay safe in the sunshine.

We will be extending our vocabulary through reading nonfiction texts and poetry linked with our topic and using all of our senses through a variety of provision designed to facilitate the best learning.
