#### Face Covering – message from Fr Brian

I recently discovered that the Bishops of England and Wales no longer require Eucharistic Ministers to wear face coverings when distributing Holy Communion. Therefore from the weekend of 24<sup>th</sup>/25<sup>th</sup> September the priests and ministers will no longer wear face coverings. Of course, this issue will be kept under review in case there is an upsurge in Covid infections in the coming months. If any of you are uncomfortable with this change please contact me personally and I will do my best to answer your concerns.

#### Volunteers needed at St Mary's School

School Streets are temporary traffic-free zones near to school entrances, aimed at tackling the congestion, poor air quality and road-safety concerns that many schools experience at drop-off and pick-up times.

In a project delivered in partnership between St Mary's School, charity Sustrans and Cornwall Council, the area in front of the school will be closed to temporarily restrict vehicle access between 8-9am and 3-4pm during term-time from mid-September.

Volunteers are needed to set up the barriers on the road and inform drivers of the road-closure and why it is happening.

### Parish Trip to Mount Edgumbe House and Country Park

Our parish trip to Mount Edgumbe is booked for Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2022. Pick up at St Mary's Falmouth is at 9am, arriving at Mount Edgumbe approximately 11.am. Departing Mount Edgumbe 16.30, arriving in Falmouth approximately 18.30. **Cost per person for the coach is £10.** Admission to the Country Park is free. **If you wish to visit the house, admission tickets per person: £9, Concessions £7, Children £5.** Visits to the house are timed entry: 11.30am -12.30pm, 12.30pm – 1.30pm, 2pm – 3pm, 3pm – 4pm. There is a lift within the house that allows those with walking difficulties to reach the first floor which includes the access to the exhibition rooms. Lunch options: The Mount Edgumbe estate has two cafes or you can bring your own packed lunch. Please book your place on the sign up sheet, if you wish to visit the house, **please make sure you tick that box.** We have booked a 53 seater coach so places are limited. £10 per person for the coach needs to be paid at the time of booking. You are welcome to leave your car in the car park at Falmouth

This Sunday we celebrate Evangelii Gaudium Sunday

Evangelii Gaudium Sunday calls us to be joyous in proclaiming our faith. "Evangelii Gaudium" is Latin for "Joy of the Gospel". The day supports the work carried out by the Mission Directorate at the Bishops' Conference in supporting our bishops in three important areas:

- Firstly, evangelisation and catechesis. Guided by the Bishops, this work supports the dioceses in bringing the beauty of the Catholic Faith to the people in their parishes, and to those who do not yet know the Lord.
- Secondly, the beauty of the Liturgy and our church buildings. The Mission directorate ensures that liturgical directives from Rome are acted upon and liturgical texts are translated into English. Historical building experts work in the Directorate and support dioceses to fund and maintain beautiful places for prayer.
- Thirdly, sharing the beauty of the Catholic faith with Christian and non-Christians through outreach and dialogue. This work supports the bishops at the national level and helps create greater understanding. The directorate also reaches out to those with no faith, but who seek the Lord "with a sincere heart".

Please support the Mission Directorate through prayer and giving to the second collection. However much you give, big or small, it will go directly to support these three important areas of work.
