

BIG Question: How can we look after our seaside?

This topic is really going to make the most of our lovely local environment as the children go out and about at the seaside. They will learn about simple classification of living things. They will consider how our environment can be polluted and think about their role in protecting it. Exciting artwork in class then sand sculpture on the beaches will get the children to take an even closer look at shells and creatures. They will create their own seaside picnic and while they are enjoying the seaside today they will compare a local beach with past photos and also study the amusements and activities that took place on seaside holidays from the past.

Practise at Home:
